

State Forest Survey Service established In Lithuania

State Forest Survey Service was established in 02-01-2003 and is responsible for:

- 1) National forest inventory by sampling method,
- 2) Lithuanian State forest cadastre,
- 3) Management and updating of standwise forest inventory data base and forest information system in the Republic of Lithuania,
- 4) National forest assessment, estimation of allowable cuttings,
- 5) Accumulation, treatment, publication and dissemination of statistical data on the forests, forestry, forest and wood products trade,
- 6) Fulfilment of the forests health monitoring.

For the realization of these tasks there are 4 departments in State Forest Survey Service: National

Forest Inventory Department, Forest Information and Cadastre Department, Forestry Statistics and Forest Assessment Department, Informatics Department. The Forestry Statistics and Forest Assessment Department was established on the basis of the Centre of Forest Economics (MEC).

A total of 39 employees work at the State Forest Survey Service.
